Dear Parent or Carer,

Following the success of GCSE intervention last half term, subject specific sessions will recommence after school as of Monday 17th January from 3.30pm until 4.15pm.

This initiative has ran the last two years and proved to be extremely successful in supporting students leading up to exams. We found that providing students with an opportunity to work on specific catch up areas greatly benefitted them in terms of the progress they made towards GCSE target grades.
